Welcome to Raven's Throat Outfitters,

Thank you for your interest in hunting with us in the incredible MacKenzie Mountains. 2018 was another amazing season. We had lots and lots of challenging weather. The old timers said it was the worst weather they'd seen in 40-50 years. With that being said, huge thanks to our tenacious, hardworking guides and crew, as well as a super group of hunters. We kicked butt!!

The guides and hunters didn't get to enjoy base camp as much this year but when they did, we were celebrating great trophies. We harvested 20 rams, 5 of which were Fannins, 6 were 40" or better and our age class averaged 10.5 years old. Our longest ram was 43" and our oldest ram was 15+ years old. Incredible. Our caribou herd is huge and healthy. With the big winter and rainy summer, they were dispersed throughout the area. Our hunters enjoyed great caribou hunting. Every hunter who hunted caribou took a great bull. As with every year, our herd gets bigger and bigger as the season progresses. We love caribou and are so lucky to have such a strong, healthy herd in our area. Alaska-Yukon moose hunts were wonderful. Due to the early cold weather, our moose came out of the woodwork. We took 7 bulls for 7 hunters.

Our B/C gross average was over 200" and our widest bull, 65". As always, we saw some absolute monsters that lived to breed another season.

At Raven's Throat we strive to have a very conservative management plan. This area is so special, and it is such an honor to hunt here and share it with the wildlife. We target 9.5 year old or older rams and old, mature moose and caribou. I believe the old, stronger genetically superior animals are critical to the entire population's health. We do not and will not over harvest any of our populations. We do post season scouting and classifying and love seeing a large excess of older trophy animals left to breed and lead the younger animals to the best winter ranges. This also makes it very exciting heading into the next season.

My wife, Ginger and I, as well as our crew, feel very honored and blessed to outfit in this magnificent wilderness. We invite you to share an unforgettable adventure with us in one of the finest game rich areas in North America.






